The Last Will and Testament of Peter Webber of Lakeville

In the name of God. Amen.

I, Peter Webber of Lakeville in the County of Halifax and Province of Nova Scotia being weak in body but sound and perfect mind and memory considering the uncertainty of this mortal life and being of sound memory blessed be Almighty God for the same, do make and publish this my last will and testament, in manner and form following, (that is to say,) First of all I give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Mary a respectable maintenance during the term of her natural life by my son Jacob to whom I bequeath the homestead or property on which I am now living also the stock consisting of a Cow an Ox and Steer one sheep a Plough and Harrow and share of the undivided property. I do also give and bequeath unto my beloved son Peter a Cap Gun, and an equal share of the undivided property.

I do give and bequeath unto my Beloved son Henry my flint Gun and an equal share of the undivided property.

I do also give and bequeath unto my beloved son William Thirty three Acres of land said lot of land being a part of the property on which I am now living and an equal share of the undivided property.

I do also give and bequeath unto my beloved son Alexander Thirty three acres of the property on which I am now living also an equal share of the undivided property.

I do give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Catherine Ann Moser a Heifer Calf and a share of the undivided property.

I do give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Elizabeth Rachel one sheep and an equal share of the undivided property.

I do give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Sarah a Heifer Calf and an equal share of the undivided property.

I do give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Mary Magdalene a Heifer Calf and an equal share of the undivided property.

I do give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Matilda Ann a Cow and an equal share of the undivided property.

I do also appoint Philip Mitchel Senior and William Falkner sole executors of this my last Will and Testament.
